BY-LAW No. 932-2010

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Evenwood Avenue, Closson Drive and Newmains Court.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1) <u>Intersection</u>	(In Column 2) <u>Stop Street</u>
Closson Drive at Evenwood Avenue	Closson Drive
Evenwood Avenue at Newmains Court	Evenwood Avenue
Evenwood Avenue at Closson Drive	Evenwood Avenue
Newmains Court at Evenwood Avenue	Newmains Court

2. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1) <u>Intersection</u>	(In Column 2) <u>Stop Street</u>
Evenwood Avenue at Newmains Court	Evenwood Avenue (eastbound)
Evenwood Avenue at Closson Drive	Evenwood Avenue (westbound)
Newmains Court at Evenwood Avenue	Newmains Court (southbound)
