BY-LAW No. 990-2010

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 844, Waste Collections, Residential Properties by making a technical amendment to the garbage chute policy.

WHEREAS on July 6, 7 and 8, 2010, Council adopted a revised multi-residential billing system and rate structure for bulk collection customers; and

WHEREAS as part of the revised multi-residential billing system and rate structure, the compaction ratio of un-compacted garbage to compacted garbage was changed from 3:1 to 2:1; and

WHEREAS on February 22 and 23, 2010, Council adopted a policy on the closing of garbage chutes within multi-residential buildings which was implemented by By-law No. 478-2010; and

WHEREAS within that policy the compaction ratio of un-compacted garbage to compacted garbage was set as 3:1; and

WHEREAS a technical amendment needs to be made to ensure that the compaction ratio is consistent between programs for multi-residential buildings; and

WHEREAS under § 169-26 of Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 844, Waste Collection, Residential Properties, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, is amended by deleting "3:1" from § 844-36A(1) and replacing it with "2:1".
