BY-LAW No. 992-2010

To amend former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 72, being a by-law "To regulate the transportation of inflammable liquids on Metropolitan Roads over Rapid Transit subways" to provide an exemption on Finch Avenue West between Tangiers Road and Romfield Lane and on Keele Street between St. Regis Crescent and The Pond Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 72, being a by-law "To regulate the transportation of inflammable liquids on Metropolitan Roads over Rapid Transit subways", is amended by:
 - A. Deleting the period at the end of subsection 2(e) and inserting in lieu thereof the following: ", nor".
 - B. Inserting a new subsection (f) and a new subsection (g) in section 2 as follows:
 - "(f) to prevent the transportation of inflammable liquids along or upon Finch Avenue West between Tangiers Road and Romfield Lane, nor
 - (g) to prevent the transportation of inflammable liquids along or upon Keele Street between St. Regis Crescent and The Pond Road."
