## BY-LAW No. 993-2010

To name the private access road, extending easterly from the intersection of Petrolia Road and The Pond Road, as "Apollo Place".

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to name the said private access road was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on August 17, 2010, and it is appropriate to name the private access road, extending easterly from the intersection of Petrolia Road and The Pond Road, as "Apollo Place";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


- 1. The private access road, extending easterly from the intersection of Petrolia Road and The Pond Road, and shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated July 28, 2010 is named "Apollo Place";
- 2. Fifty-Five Developments Limited, its agents or successors, shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage estimated to be in the amount of \$300.00; and
- 3. The owners of the private access road or their successors shall maintain at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
