BY-LAW No. 1028-2010

To amend By-law No. 889-2009 to extend the period of interim control affecting those lands in the Consumers Employment Area generally bounded by Sheppard Avenue East to the north, Victoria Park Avenue to the east, Highway 401 to the south and Highway 404 to the west.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has, by adopting Motion MM40.11 and enacting By-law No. 889-2009 at its meeting of September 30 and October 1, 2009, directed that a review be undertaken of the regulations and policies pertaining to places of worship in the Consumers Employment Area; and

WHEREAS Council at its meeting of August 25, 26 and 27, 2010 adopted the recommendations of the report dated July 15, 2010 from the Director, Community Planning, North York District recommending an extension of the period of interim control to two years;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 889-2009 to effect interim control for the lands in the Consumers Employment Area is amended by deleting from Section 2 the words "one year" and replacing them with the words "two years".
