- 1. The area outlined by the heavy lines shown on the map attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law is designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18.
- 2. The heritage conservation district plan prepared by E.R. A. Architects Inc. for the Kingswood Road South Heritage Conservation District dated June 5, 2009, is adopted.
- **3.** A copy of the Kingswood Road South Heritage Conservation District Plan is available for inspection at the offices of the City of Toronto Planning Division, Heritage Preservation Services, City Hall, 100 Queen Street West, Toronto, Ontario and on the City's web site at www.toronto.ca/heritage-preservation/heritage_districts.htm.
