BY-LAW No. 1139-2010

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Lansdowne Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
- A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:
