**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1150-2010**

**To dedicate and name certain land north of Fleet Street extending easterly from Bastion Street for public highway purposes to form the public highway Sloping Sky Mews.**

WHEREAS the City of Toronto acquired lands for new public highway purposes pursuant to Section 37 Agreements registered as AT1195695, AT1499435 and AT1386376;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of the Water Lot in Front of the Plan of the Ordnance Reserve and parts of Blocks A and B on Plan D-1444 designated as PARTS 105, 110, 115, 118 and 131 on Plan 66R-21894

PIN 21418-0200 (LT)

Part of Block A on Plan D-1444 designated as PART 5 on Plan 66R-21894

Part of PIN 21418-0180 (LT)

Part of Block A on Plan D-1444 designated as PART 6 on Plan 66R-21894

Part of PIN 21418-0172 (LT)

Part of the Water Lot in Front of the Plan of the Ordnance Reserve designated as PARTS 15, 16, 17 and 19 on Plan 66R-21894

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated to form the public highway Sloping Sky Mews.

2. The land described in Section 1 of this By-law is named as "Sloping Sky Mews".
