## BY-LAW No. 1175-2010

## To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 693, Signs, Article II, Election Signs with respect to timing restrictions concerning the display of election signs related to the 2010 Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Council may pass by-laws to regulate signs and other advertising devices under subsection 8(2) of the *City of Toronto Act*, 2006, as amended (the "Act") subject to the additional powers and rules in section 110 of the Act; and

WHEREAS the City provides regulation of election signs to the citizens of Toronto as a necessary and desirable service; and

WHEREAS notice of the intention to enact this by-law has been provided in accordance with the Act and The City of Toronto Municipal Code;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 693, Signs, Article II, Election Signs of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by inserting the phrase, "with the exception of the 2010 municipal election where election signs shall not be erected or displayed for a municipal election until 21 days prior to voting day" immediately after the phrase "voting day" where it appears in subsection B of section 693-9.
