BY-LAW No. 1370-2011

To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 68, Museums, to require the adoption of policies respecting sponsorship and naming.

WHEREAS City Council has established policies respecting the approval and entering into of agreements for sponsorships and naming rights, and the approval of honourific and street naming; and

WHEREAS the new policies shall apply to those agencies, boards and commissions of the City such as the board of management of Sir William Campbell House Museum so as to require the board to adopt policies consistent with the policies of Council, provided that the board may continue to approve proposals where it has previously been delegated the authority to do so; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend Chapter 68 to include this requirement;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 68, Museums, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Toronto is amended by deleting § 68-9 and substituting the following:

§ 68-9. Management and control of Premises.

- A. Subject to this Article, the Board may make rules as it considers necessary relating to the management and control of the Premises and may fix charges for the use of all or any part of the Premises as it considers advisable.
- B. The Board shall adopt policies respecting sponsorships, naming rights and honourific names which are consistent with the policies adopted by Council.
