## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 1374-2011

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 103, Heritage, to require the adoption of policies respecting sponsorship and naming.

WHEREAS City Council has established policies respecting the approval and entering into of agreements for sponsorships and naming rights, and the approval of honourific and street naming; and

WHEREAS the new policies shall apply to those agencies, boards and commissions of the City such as museum management boards and Heritage Toronto so as to require the boards to adopt policies consistent with the policies of Council, provided that the boards may continue to approve proposals where they have previously been delegated the authority to do so; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend Chapter 103 to include this requirement;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 103, Heritage, be amended by:
  - A. Adding the following subsection to § 103-2 as follows:
    - C. Sponsorships; naming rights; honourific names.

The Museum Board shall adopt policies respecting sponsorships, naming rights and honourific names which are consistent with the policies adopted by Council.

- B. Adding the following clause to Subsection 103-3H as follows:
  - (8) The Management Board shall adopt policies respecting sponsorships, naming rights and honourific names which are consistent with the policies adopted by Council.
- C. Adding the following subsection to § 103-14 as follows:
  - D. Heritage Toronto shall adopt policies respecting sponsorships, naming rights and honourific names which are consistent with the policies adopted by Council.
