BY-LAW No. 32-2012

To amend By-law No. 31001 of the former City of North York, respecting the regulation of traffic on North York roads, regarding Barse Street and Marmion Avenue.

The North York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "XVIII" (Through Highways) of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by deleting from Columns 1 and 2 the following:

Barse St.	The northerly limit of Fairlawn Ave.	The southerly limit of Melrose Ave.

2. Schedule "XVIII" (Through Highways) of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by adding to Columns 1 and 2 the following:

<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
Barse Street	Melrose Avenue	Old Orchard Grove

3. Schedule "XIX" (Stop Signs) of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by adding to Columns 1 and 2 the following:

COLUMN 1	COLUMN 2
<u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>STOP STREET</u>
Barse Street and Marmion Avenue	Barse Street, north and south of Marmion Avenue
Barse Street and Marmion Avenue	Marmion Avenue, east and west of Barse Street
