BY-LAW No. 164-2012

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking and
By-law No. 1409-2011 to correct minor technical errors.**

WHEREAS on December 1, 2011 City Council enacted By-law No. 1409-2011, a By-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, to consolidate and incorporate provisions to regulate traffic and parking within the City of Toronto"; and

WHEREAS under Section 169-26B of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to The City of Toronto Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law No. 1409-2011 and Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, including the related Schedules thereto, be amended by deleting all references to "Schedule XXXX" and replacing same with "Schedule XL".
2. That By-law No. 1409-2011 and Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, including the related Schedules thereto, be amended by deleting all references to "Schedule XXXXI" and replacing same with "Schedule XLI".
3. That By-law No. 1409-2011 and Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, including the related Schedules thereto, be amended by deleting all references to "Schedule XXXXII" and replacing same with "Schedule XLII".
4. That Section 2 of By-law No. 1409-2011 be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "2. This By-law shall take effect 30 days after the date of the first approved set fine order from the Regional Senior Justice of the Ontario Court of Justice for this amended Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking."
