BY-LAW No. 167-2012

To amend By-law No. 31001 of the former City of North York, respecting the regulation of traffic on North York roads, regarding Hullmar Drive and York Gate Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "XIII" (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by adding to Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 the following:
