CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 207-2012

To amend By-law No. 226-1998 to appoint Mario M. Angelucci as Deputy Chief Building Official and to repeal the appointment of James K. Laughlin as Deputy Chief Building Official.

WHEREAS subsection 3(2) of the *Building Code Act, 1992*, S.O. 1992, c.23, as amended requires the council of each municipality to appoint a chief building official; and

WHEREAS under section 77 of the *Legislation Act, 2006*, S.O. 2006, c. 21, as amended, the power to appoint a person to a public office includes the power to remove the person and the power to appoint a deputy with the same powers as the holder of the office, subject to specified conditions, or with limited powers as specified; and

WHEREAS under section 67 of the *Legislation Act, 2006*, S.O. 2006, c. 21, as amended, words in the singular include the plural; and

WHEREAS Council has determined that Mario M. Angelucci will succeed James K. Laughlin as Deputy Chief Building Official of the South District;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 3(1) of By-law No. 226-1998, as amended, is further amended by deleting the words "James K. Laughlin" and substituting "Mario M. Angelucci".
2. Subsection 3(2) of By-law No. 226-1998, as amended, is further amended by deleting the words "James K. Laughlin" from Column 1 – Deputy and substituting "Mario M. Angelucci".
3. This by-law comes into force immediately.
