BY-LAW No. 273-2012

To authorize the alteration of St. Clarens Avenue, between Dundas Street West and College Street, by the installation of two speed humps.

WHEREAS a traffic calming poll of households on St. Clarens Avenue, between Dundas Street West and College Street, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on St. Clarens Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of two speed humps on St. Clarens Avenue, between Dundas Street West and College Street, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-0403, dated July 2011, attached to this By-law.
