BY-LAW No. 410-2012

To authorize the alteration of Eileen Avenue, between Scarlett Road and the westerly limit of Eileen Avenue, by the installation of two speed humps.

WHEREAS a traffic calming poll of households on Eileen Avenue was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Etobicoke York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Eileen Avenue;

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of two speed humps on Eileen Avenue, between Scarlett Road and the westerly limit of Eileen Avenue, generally as shown on Drawing EY11-101B dated June 2011 attached to this By-law.


