**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 482-2012**

**To dedicate land on the east side of Leslie Street, south of Lake Shore Boulevard East, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Leslie Street.**

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired for highway widening and municipal purposes by transfers registered as ES62570 and ES62612 but never formally dedicated it for public highway purposes by by-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21385-0197 (LT)

Parts of Blocks I and RO on Plan 520E designated as PART 3 on Plan 66R-24965

Part of PIN 21385-0131 (LT)

Parts of Blocks I and RO on Plan 520E designated as PART 6 on Plan 66R-24965

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Leslie Street.
