BY-LAW No. 568-2012

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Cardwell Avenue.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1) Highway	(From Column 2) Side	(From Column 3) From	To	(From Column 4) Times or Days
Cardwell Avenue	South	137 metres east of Kennedy Road	153 metres east of Kennedy Road	Anytime

2. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1) Highway	(In Column 2) Side	(In Column 3) From	To	(In Column 4) Times or Days
Cardwell Avenue	South	152 metres east of Kennedy Road	15 metres further east	Anytime

3. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1) Highway	(In Column 2) Side	(In Column 3) From	To	(In Column 4) Times or Days	(In Column 5) Maximum Period Permitted
Cardwell Avenue	South	137 metres east of Kennedy Road	15 metres further east	Monday to Friday	15 minutes
Cardwell Avenue	North	210 metres east of Kennedy Road	15 metres further east	Monday to Friday	15 minutes
