BY-LAW No. 569-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Cardwell Avenue.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of the City of Toronto is hereby amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Cardwell Avenue	South	A point 137 metres east of Kennedy Road and a point 16 metres further east	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Cardwell Avenue	South	A point 152 metres east of Kennedy Road and a point 15 metres further east	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Cardwell Avenue	North	A point 210 metres east of Kennedy Road and a point 15 metres further east	Mon. to Fri.	15 mins.
