BY-LAW No. 580-2012

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Charles Tupper Drive and various streets.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1) Intersection	(In Column 2) Stop Street
Charles Tupper Drive and McCulley Street	Charles Tupper Drive
McCulley Street and Langevin Crescent (west intersection)	McCulley Street
Langevin Crescent and McCulley Street (east intersection)	Langevin Crescent
Langevin Crescent and Charles Tupper Drive	Langevin Crescent
