BY-LAW No. 609-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, to permit bicycles to park at an angle of 90 degrees at on-street bike corrals.

WHEREAS on December 1, 2011, City Council enacted By-law No. 1409-2011, a By-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, to consolidate and incorporate provisions to regulate traffic and parking within the City of Toronto"; and

WHEREAS Toronto and East York Community Council adopted Item 15.44, thereby adopting an amendment to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, as enacted by By-law No. 1409-2011, as further amended;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by inserting a new subsection (3) in §§ 950-404B as follows:

"(3) Where bicycles only angle parking is permitted on a highway as set out in Schedule XII in §§ 950-1311, despite Subsection B(1), a bicycle may be parked at a 90 degree angle to the curb."

2. This by-law shall come into effect 30 days after approval of the first set fine order for City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950 offences subsequent to the enactment of this by-law.
