BY-LAW No. 641-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting bicycle lanes on Queens Quay West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Queens Quay West	Lower Portland Street and Bathurst Street	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:
