BY-LAW No. 756-2012

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law "To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Barker Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Road)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Barker Avenue	South	Coxwell Avenue and a point 58 metres west of Glebemount Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

2. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Barker Avenue	South	Coxwell Avenue and Fairside Avenue	Anytime
Barker Avenue	South	Fairside Avenue and a point 58 metres west of Glebemount Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.
