BY-LAW No. 821-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Rustic Road.

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of the City of Toronto is hereby amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Rustic Road	South	Culford Road and a point opposite the westerly limit of Blue Springs Road	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Rustic Road	South	Culford Road and a point 78 metres west	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Rustic Road	South	Blue Springs Road and a point 52 metres west	Anytime
Rustic Road	South	Culford Road and a point 58 metres east	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Mon. to Fri.

D. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Rustic Road	South	Culford Road and a point 58 metres east	9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. of one day to 7:00 a.m. of the next following day, Mon. to Fri.; Anytime Sat. and Sun.	1 hour
