BY-LAW No. 922-2012

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law "To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Woodington Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Times and Days)	(In Column 5 Max. Period Permitted)
Woodington Avenue	Both	Springdale Boulevard and a point 38 metres south	10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	1 hour
Woodington Avenue	East	Springdale Boulevard and Sammon Avenue	10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri. during the months of Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr., June, Aug., Oct. and Dec.	1 hour
Woodington Avenue	West	Springdale Boulevard and Sammon Avenue	10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri. during the months of May, Jul., Sept. and Nov.	1 hour
