CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 1006-2012

To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 1154-2010, City of Toronto By-law No. 232-2011 and City of Toronto By-law No. 233-2011 to amend the effective date of previous amendments.

WHEREAS under Section 169-26 of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to The City of Toronto Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. City of Toronto By-law No. 1154-2010 is amended by deleting Section 19 and replacing it with the following Section 19:
 - "19. A. Section 3 of this by-law shall come into effect the first Thursday following 45 days after approval of the first set fine order for Part II offences for City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, subsequent to the enactment of this by-law.
 - B. Sections 1, 2, 5 and 7 of this by-law shall come into effect on July 12, 2012.
 - C. Section 4 of this by-law shall come into effect 30 days after approval of the first set fine order for City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, subsequent to the enactment of this by-law.
 - D. Section 6 of this by-law shall come into effect the first Thursday following 45 days after approval of the first set fine order for City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, subsequent to the enactment of this by-law.
 - E. Sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of this by-law shall come into effect 30 days after the date of approval by the Regional Senior Justice of the set fines required for the new or amended offences created."
2. City of Toronto By-law No. 232-2011 is amended by deleting Section 2 and replacing it with the following Section 2:
 - "2. Section 1 of this by-law shall come into effect on July 12, 2012."

3. City of Toronto By-law No. 233-2011 is amended by deleting Section 3 and replacing it with the following Section 3:

"3. Sections 1 and 2 of this by-law come into effect the first Thursday following 45 days after approval of the first set fine order for City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, subsequent to the enactment of this by-law."
