## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW No. 1031-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Use of with respect to the locking of bicycles.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of February 6 and 7, 2012, adopted, as amended Public Works and Infrastructure Committee Item 9.10, and thereby amended Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Use of, of The Toronto Municipal Code to amalgamate and harmonize the definitions and regulations respecting prohibited and regulated activities in streets, street work, encroachment in streets, maintaining boulevards, sidewalks, constructing and altering walkways and driveways, municipal remedial action, appeals, fees, administration and enforcement within the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS City Council has subsequently directed that the prohibition on the locking of bicycles to municipal property or authorized encroachments be clarified;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Use of, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following subsection to § 743-9:
  - Q. Subsection 743-9P shall not prohibit the chaining, locking or attaching of a bicycle that, in the General Manager's opinion, is in good operating condition and is not chained, locked or attached so as to damage or interfere with the use of municipal property or an authorized encroachment.
