BY-LAW No. 1038-2012

To amend former City of Etobicoke Municipal Code Chapter 231, Streets and Sidewalks, to expand the types of foodstuffs which may be sold from a street food vending cart.

WHEREAS City Council, after consideration of the report (June 14, 2012) from the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards, has decided to permit street food vendors to expand their menu choices, subject to compliance with existing by-laws and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 231, Streets and Sidewalks, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Etobicoke is amended by deleting §§ 231-23.1 and substituting the following:

§ 231-23.1 Permitted foodstuffs.

No person shall place, expose for sale or sell by retail any foodstuffs on any street, sidewalk or untravelled portion of road allowance, including in a public park or public place, from a street food vending cart except foodstuffs permitted under Ontario Regulation 562 under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, subject to compliance with the requirements of this chapter and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health.
