BY-LAW No. 1042-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, to expand the types of foods which may be sold from non-motorized refreshment vehicles.

WHEREAS City Council, after consideration of the report (June 14, 2012) from the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards, has decided to permit street food vendors to expand their menu choices, subject to compliance with existing by-laws and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Chapter 545, Licensing, of The Municipal Code of the City of Toronto is amended by deleting § 545-38J(7) and substituting the following:
 - (7) No vehicle licensed under this subsection shall be used for the preparation or sale of food products except those permitted under Ontario Regulation 562 made under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, subject to compliance with the requirements of this chapter and the approval of the Medical Officer of Health.
