BY-LAW No. 1051-2012

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
Lynedock Crescent, Roywood Drive and York Mills Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of the City of Toronto is hereby amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Roywood Drive	North	A point 9 metres west of Lynedock Crescent (east intersection) and a point 40 metres east of Lynedock Crescent (east intersection)	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.

B. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)
Roywood Drive	The north side of Sandover Drive and the south side of Lynedock Crescent

C. By inserting in Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Roywood Drive	The north side of Underpass Gate and the west side of Fenside Drive
Roywood Drive	The east side of Fenside Drive and the south side of Lynedock Crescent
