BY-LAW No. 1077-2012

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Daystrom Drive and Lindylou Road.

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, of the City of Toronto is hereby amended as follows:
