BY-LAW No. 1125-2012

To amend By-law No. 31001 of the former City of North York, respecting the regulation of traffic on North York roads, regarding Gladys Allison Place.

The North York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "VIII" (No Parking) of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by deleting from Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 the following:
