BY-LAW No. 1150-2012

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Gaitwin Place.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Gaitwin Place	Both	Brimorton Drive and a point 15 metres northeast	Anytime

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Gaitwin Place	East	Brimorton Drive and a point 40 metres northeast	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday Except July, August and Public Holidays
Gaitwin Place	West	Brimorton Drive and a point 37 metres northeast	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday Except July, August and Public Holidays
