BY-LAW No. 1187-2012

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Abbs Street, Hallam Street, Kenneth Avenue, Lawlor Avenue and Silver Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Abbs Street	North	A point 45.5 metres west of Brock Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Kenneth Avenue	South	A point 9.0 metres east of Indian Road Crescent and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
Lawlor Avenue	West	A point 49 metres south of Gerrard Street East and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Silver Avenue	North	A point 52 metres east of Golden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Hallam Street	South	A point 23 metres west of Concord Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
