**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1215-2012**

**To permanently close the public highway being part of Judge Road adjoining  
126, 127 and 128 Judge Road.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public highway that is a portion of Judge Road adjoining 126, 127 and 128 Judge Road, be permanently closed as a public highway; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of the highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Etobicoke York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on September 11, 2012;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public highway being a portion of Judge Road adjoining 126, 127 and 128 Judge Road, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of Judge Road, South of Six Points Road  
City of Toronto, designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 66R-25802
