**BY-LAW No. 1464-2012**

**To amend By-law No. 31001 of the former City of North York, respecting the regulation of traffic on former North York roads, regarding Falstaff Avenue.**

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "X" (Parking for Restricted Times) of By-law Number 31001, of the former City of North York, is amended by adding to Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 the following:
