BY-LAW No. 1506-2012

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Portwine Drive, Stotts Terrace and Frank Faubert Drive.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street)
Portwine Drive (east intersection) and Lawrence Avenue East	Portwine Drive (east intersection)
Portwine Drive (west intersection) and Lawrence Avenue East	Portwine Drive (west intersection)
Stotts Terrace and Lawrence Avenue East	Stotts Terrace
Stotts Terrace and Portwine Drive	Stotts Terrace
Frank Faubert Drive (east intersection) and Lawrence Avenue East	Frank Faubert Drive (east intersection)

2. Schedule XX (Heavy Truck Prohibition) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	From	(In Column 2 To)	(In Column 3 Times or Days)
Portwine Drive	Lawrence Avenue East (east intersection)	Lawrence Avenue East (west intersection)	Anytime
Stotts Terrace	Lawrence Avenue East	Portwine Drive	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	From	(In Column 2 To)	(In Column 3 Times or Days)
Frank Faubert Drive	Lawrence Avenue East (east intersection)	Lawrence Avenue East (west intersection)	Anytime
