BY-LAW No. 1511-2012

To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, respecting the regulation of traffic on Staines Road and Hepatica Street.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XVIII (Through Streets) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by deleting the following words and figures from Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 From	To)
Staines Road	North limit of Morningside Avenue	South limit of Steeles Avenue East

2. Schedule XVIII (Through Streets) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Staines Road	South limit of Steeles Avenue East	North limit of Hepatica Street
Staines Road	North limit of Morningside Avenue	South limit of Hepatica Street

3. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:
