**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1653-2012**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, and  
By-law No. 206-2012 to correct a minor technical error.**

WHEREAS on February 7, 2012 City Council enacted By-law No. 206-2012 a By-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting miscellaneous technical amendments"; and

WHEREAS under Section 169-26B of Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to correct a typographical error;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended by:
  - A. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended to re-enact § 545-2A(3) Every person who owns a barber-shop and every person who owns a hairdressing establishment.
  - B. City of Toronto Municipal Code 545, Licensing, is amended to repeal § 545-2A(30).
2. Section 1(1) of City of Toronto By-law No. 206-2012 is repealed.
3. This by-law is deemed to have come into effect on February 7, 2012.
