BY-LAW No. 1081-2013

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Shaw Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Shaw Street	Bloor Street West and Dewson Street	Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Shaw Street	A point 70 metres south of Dewson Street and College Street	Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Shaw Street	Bloor Street West and Barton Avenue	Northbound lane, adjacent to the easterly southbound curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Shaw Street	Dundas Street West and Bloor Street West	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Shaw Street	Douro Street and a point 17.3 metres north	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Shaw Street	Douro Street and King Street West	Westerly Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime

Shaw Street	King Street West and a point 43.2 metres south	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Shaw Street	A point 17.3 metres north of Douro Street and a point 43.2 metres south of King Street West	Easterly Northbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime
