BY-LAW No. 682-2014

To amend By-law No. 120-2014 to authorize the use of internet voting in the advance vote for elections after the regular election in 2014.

Whereas subsection 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, provides that a municipality may, by by-law authorize electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 1 of By-law No. 120-2014 is repealed, and sections 2 and 3 are re-numbered as sections 1 and 2.
2. The words "elections after" shall be added after the words "authorized for" in sections 1 and 2 as renumbered.
3. The words "by electors having a disability" shall be deleted from sections 1 and 2 as renumbered.
