BY-LAW No. 695-2014

To repeal interim control By-law No. 963-2013 effecting lands on Bathurst Street from Queen Street West to Dupont Street.

Whereas City of Toronto Council at its meeting on July 16, 17, 18 and 19, 2013 enacted Interim Control By-law No. 963-2013 to prohibit a gross floor area of non-residential uses that is greater than that which lawfully existed on July 19, 2013 on Bathurst Street from Queen Street West to Dupont Street; and

Whereas the Council-directed planning study focusing on built form and land use on both sides of Bathurst Street from Dupont to Queen Street is now complete;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law No. 963-2013 being an interim control by-law affecting those lands generally bounded by Queen Street West to the south, the Dupont Street train tracks to the north and the properties fronting onto Bathurst Street to the east and the west is hereby repealed.
