BY-LAW No. 486-2015

To repeal former City of Scarborough By-law No. 23204, being a by-law "To require lifeguards at apartment buildings and to regulate the lifeguards".

Whereas the *Borough of Scarborough Act, 1975* authorized the enactment of City of Scarborough By-law No. 23204, being a by-law "To require lifeguards at apartment buildings and to regulate the lifeguards" (the "By-law"); and

Whereas lifeguards and public pools, including pools in apartments, are regulated in the Province of Ontario by Regulation 565, Public Pools, under the authority of the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* (the "Regulation"); and

Whereas the requirements for lifeguards at apartment pools in the By-law are more onerous than corresponding requirements in the Regulation; and

Whereas the requirements for lifeguards at apartment pools in the City of Toronto, except apartment pools in the former City of Scarborough, are governed solely by the Regulation;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Former City of Scarborough By-law No. 23204, being a by-law "To require lifeguards at apartment buildings and to regulate the lifeguards" is repealed.
