## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW No. 795-2015

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Parliament Street, Queens Quay East, Queens Quay West and Royal York Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Parliament Street	Small Street and Lake Shore Boulevard East	Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Queens Quay East	Yonge Street and Small Street	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Queens Quay West	Bathurst Street and Stadium Road	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Queens Quay West	Dan Leckie Way and Bathurst Street	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Queens Quay West	Lower Spadina Avenue and Dan Leckie Way	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Queens Quay West	Lower Spadina Avenue and Dan Leckie Way	Westbound lane adjacent to the curb/lay-bys used for loading purposes	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Queens Quay East	Yonge Street and Lower Jarvis Street	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Royal York Road	A point 125 metres north of Government Road and Ashley Park Road	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Royal York Road	A point 52 metres north of a point opposite the north side of Government Road and a point 70 metres north of Ashley Road	Westerly Southbound	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Queens Quay West	Bathurst Street and Stadium Road	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
