BY-LAW No. 9-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Cameron Avenue, Gilmour Avenue, Nairn Avenue, Norman Avenue, Ravenal Street and St. Clarens Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Gilmour Avenue	West	A point 58.5 metres north of Annette Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Nairn Avenue	West	A point 16.6 metres south of Rogers Road and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
St. Clarens Avenue	West	A point 9 metres north of Brandon Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Cameron Avenue	South	A point 95.1 metres east of Silverthorn Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
Gilmour Avenue	West	A point 34 metres south of Dundas Street West and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

Norman Avenue	North	A point 35.8 metres east of Gilbert Avenue and a point 6.3 metres further east	Anytime
Ravenal Street	East	A point 80.3 metres north of Henrietta Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
