**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 75-2016**

**To amend the legal description contained in By-law No. 653-2015, as amended by By-law No. 950-2015, respecting the partial closure of a portion of Eglinton Avenue West and a portion of Dufferin Street.**

Whereas City of Toronto By-law Nos. 653-2015 and 950-2015 each contained a technical error in the legal description; and

Whereas Section 169-26B of The City of Toronto Municipal Code authorizes the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk to submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 1 of By-law No. 653-2015, as amended by By-law No. 950-2015, is deleted and replaced with the following:

1. Part of the public highway known as Eglinton Avenue West and a portion of Dufferin Street, abutting 1817 Dufferin Street, described as follows, is permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 10450-0031 (LT)

Part of Lot 30 on Concession 3 FTB TWP of York, City of Toronto (formerly City of York)

Designated as Part 2 on Plan 66R-28046

Part of PIN 10449-0032 (LT)

Part of Lot 10 on Plan 375 TWP of York, City of Toronto (formerly City of York)

Designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-28046

Enacted and passed on February 4, 2016.
