CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 294-2016

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways,
to update reference to the General Manager, Transportation Services, and to delete
Section 937-2.1.**

Whereas pursuant to Subsection 169-26B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization; and

Whereas the "Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services of the City of Toronto" is now the "General Manager of Transportation Services of the City of Toronto"; and

Whereas the authority delegated to the General Manager, Transportation Services, in Section 937-2.1 has expired;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended by:
 - A. Deleting the phrase: "Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services" wherever it occurs in the Code Chapter and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase: "General Manager of Transportation Services".
 - B. Deleting Section 937-2.1.
 - C. Deleting from Section 937-4 the phrase: ", 937-2.1".
