BY-LAW No. 295-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, to authorize the General Manager of Transportation Services to approve road closures up to and including 365 consecutive days for the Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown LRT Project.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended as follows:

1. By inserting a new section 937-3.2 as follows:

"§ 937-3.2 Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown LRT Project.

Despite any other by-law, until January 1, 2022, the General Manager of Transportation Services may temporarily close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic any highway or portion of a highway for a period up to and including 365 consecutive days as required for the purposes of the construction of the Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown LRT Project."

2. By amending Section 937-4 to delete the phrase: "and 937-3" and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase ", 937-3 and 937-3.2".
