BY-LAW No. 298-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Bayview Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway) | (From Column 2 Direction) | (From Column 3 Turns Prohibited) | (From Column 4 Times and/or Days) |
|---|---------------------------------|---|--|
| Bayview Avenue (west side) and the access to No. 1860 Bayview Avenue, located at a point 80 metres north of Broadway Avenue | Northbound | Left | 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri. |

B. By inserting in Schedule XX (Two-Way Left-Turn-Only Lanes) in § 950-1319, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) |
|-----------------------------|--|
| Bayview Avenue | A point 22 metres north of Broadway Avenue and a point 80 metres further north |
